

Villa Rota



VILLA ROTA - This grand villa belonged until the mid 1900s to the Conti Pasolini and was their country residence until the end of the First World War. Built at the beginning of the 18th century its architecture is typical of earlier 15th and 16th century Romagnola villa-castles, buildings which combined the need for protection with that of relaxation. In fact the building has no external staircase for reasons of security, instead having a large welcoming doorway on the first floor which allows light to enter the central hall, which is characterised by its delicate decorations which have been expertly restored.



The four symmetrical rooms on either side of the hall also have some interesting decorative features such as a beautiful Baroque fireplace and linear decorations which are a different colour in every room. An atmospheric area of parkland full of ornamental plants and ancient trees surrounds the villa. Hidden among the trees is a little family chapel in classical style.
